Indications

Relief of the following symptoms:

Skin roughness, acne/skin eruption, stomatitis, angular stomatitis (swollen or cracked edges of lips), cheilitis (swollen or cracked lips), dermatitis, eczema, rashes, sores, tongue inflammation, hot flushes of the face associated with rosacea, redness of the eye, and itching of the eye.

Consult with a physician or pharmacist if no improvement is seen in these symptoms after about 1 month of use.

Supplementation of vitamin B2 in the following cases:

When physically fatigued, during pregnancy or lactation, and when physical strength is decreased during and after illness.

Dosage and Administration

Take the following dosage orally twice a day, after breakfast and dinner, with cold or hot water.

Precautions for Ingredients

- 1. Administration of vitamin C is known to influence the results of urine and stool tests, so when undertaking urine and stool testing, please inform your physician that you are taking this medicine.
- 2. Taking this medicine may cause urine to turn bright yellow, but this is due to assimilation of the vitamin B₂ contained in the medicine, with part of it being excreted in the urine. It is not a cause for concern.



Precautions

Consultation

1. If the following symptoms are observed after taking this medicine, these may be adverse reactions. Immediately discontinue the use of this medicine and show this informational leaflet to a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson for a consultation.

2. The following symptom may be observed after taking this medicine. If this symptom persists or worsens, discontinue the use of this medicine and show this informational leaflet to with a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson for a consultation.

3. If symptoms do not improve even after taking the medicine for about1 month, stop taking the medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson, bringing this informational leaflet with you.

Precautions for Storage and Handling

- 1. Store in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight.
- 2. Keep out of reach of children.
- 3. Do not transfer to a different container. Also, do not transfer other medications, etc., into this container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality.)
- 4. Moisture may alter the outer appearance of the tablets, so do not handle with wet hands.
- 5. The packing material inside the container is provided to prevent damage to the tablets during transport. After opening the cap, discard the packing material.
- 6. A desiccant is included in the container. Do not ingest the desiccant.
- 7. Do not take tablets that have exceeded their expiration date.
- 8. From the standpoint of maintaining quality, as a rule of thumb, once the cap has been opened, use the tablets within 6 months, regardless of their expiration date. There is a space marked "Date Opened" on the box's inner flap. Please use that to record the date of opening.
